Andrew Shaughnessy will focus on the unique challenges the LGBT community faces regarding healthcare. He is the Senior Field organizer at PROMO -- PROMO's goals are to help LGBT Missourians create a supportive and visible community, become active in the democratic process, and work for their equal protection under the law. They build community awareness and grassroots support for LGBT equality and increase civic participation of LGBT Missourians.

Andrew is a campaigner, human rights activist, and community organizer, originally from Ste. Genevieve, MO. He holds his B.A. in Philosophy from Missouri State University and his Masters in Human Rights from University College London. After graduating from MSU in July 2007, he took a position with the French Embassy teaching English in Bordeaux, France, where he became fluent in French. He then moved to London and attended the Rubin School of Public Policy at University College London 2008-2009, where he focused his attention on lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender rights and international law. He had the opportunity to work closely with Stonewall U.K., the British Institute for Human Rights, and was a graduate research assistant for Dr. Basak Cali's quantitative research, "Nominal Commitment's to Human Rights: A Global Survey." Upon returning to the states in 2009, Andrew volunteered and interned with PROMO. Andrew also worked on multiple campaigns in Saint Louis, including Thomas Peters for the Children, Missourians for Fair & Impartial Courts, and Barbara Fraser for State Senate. Recently, Andrew took

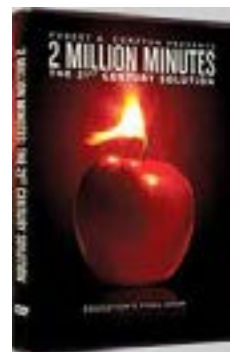
a temporary leave of absence from PROMO to work for Fairness West Virginia as the Director of Organizing and Community Outreach for their statewide LGBT nondiscrimination campaign. He is currently back in St. Louis working at PROMO.

Following two students from each country, the film creates a global snapshot of education through the eyes of students preparing for their future. It addresses what the differences in time allocation in different countries will mean for the 21st century global economy.
