Our 30th anniversary is giving us an opportunity to reflect on where we have been and dream about the possibilities of our future. Roger Goldman, one of our founders and first president recently sent us one of our very first Memos (in those days called Central Issues.)

The message from the rabbi I wrote then is no different from what I would say today. It ended, "...Any congregation that does not have at its heart kindness, tzedakah, and caring about the way we do things, not just that they get done, can really hurt us. They will surely destroy the great spirit we have inherited. Know this is nothing new, the prophet Amos said:

I loath your festivals.
I am not appeased by your solemn assemblies.
I will not accept your offerings.
Spare me the sound of your hymns.
Only let justice well up like water.
Righteousness like a mighty stream.

As long as you have me as your rabbi I will continue, with you, to search for meaning and renewal in the traditions that Amos said had become an abomination in his time. I will continue to encourage Hebrew studies, more tradition, Shabbat and the mitzvot. I do this because I believe that tradition and study are meant to guide us toward a righteous path.

Our congregation is not going to be for everyone. But those of us who join and accept the responsibility of membership must continue to care more for each other than for the institution. Then "justice will well up as water and righteousness as a mighty stream," at least at CRC.

Thirty years later we continue to work hard to infuse our worship, our festivals, and our rituals with meaning and purpose and healing. We pray that our offerings, both material and spiritual, continue to add to the repair of the brokenness and injustice we experience around us.

We continue to grow in membership and with opportunities to build connections and relationships. A few examples:

- The new blessing buddy program that pairs our elders with younger members who are looking for mentors in their lives is taking off.
- The August 8th social responsibility Shabbat will welcome our members Marylen Mann, founder of Oasis, and Marshall Cohen, founder of the Lift for Life Academy, who will tell us about a volunteer mentoring program that needs our participation.
- We have been challenged to raise awareness of labor trafficking in our area as consumers of fair food and other services.
- Our latest survey affirmed that our highest priority remains health care reform and we will deepen and expand our participation with Missouri Health Care For All and our other health partnerships.
- We are excited to welcome Rabbi Deana Sussman as Rabbi-Educator to grow our education program.
- Next Dor, our experimental program for post college/ pre-kids in their 20's and 30's, continues to incubate new ideas.
